 portion of the S.E.  $\frac{1}{4}$  Sec. 4 lying East of the 100' line

 parcels is computed to be 112 acres more or less, the parcel  
 1.41 ac. previously sold to the Town and 0.41 ac. in the  
 deviation on the South limit being excluded.
