

(6) We also beg to bring to the notice of this commission. That we feel we ought to have help in the way of appropriations for public wants of the people. Such as road, water supply, wharf, etc. as the Indians on Malcom island have.

(7) We also begin to see that we have no voice in what is to interests in Government etc.

8 You will see for yourselves our homes our lands that has been reserved for our use. This is all we have.

(X) The majority of us have only one month's fishing to keep us all the year round. And this we will soon lose. The government has reserved fishing licences for white fisherman making less for us year by year. Will the government reserve for us also some of the boats at the canneries that are canning the fishes of our rivers?

9 The government has not (as far we know) made any protection for us in the only work we are fitted for.

(10) Then too, other people can cut the timber of the province. But we are not allowed to cut the timber, on even our Indian reserves to sell.
