"Endowed by God with extraordinary talents, entrusted by his Church with unique powers, he used all for the good of his country and for the glory of God. The story of his work is the history of the Presbyterian Church in Western Canada, and white Western Canada endures, that work will abide.

To his memory and to the Glory of God this stone is crected by a few of those who loved him and counted it a joy to labour with him in his great work."

That monument of granite will become dust, blown by passing winds, but coeval with Time the monument of his Life will stand to the glory of His name who made him what he was.
