Purpose. — To teach the sound of **ow** in **cow**.

T. Say the word **cow** slowly, and give the last sound.

C. **c-ow, ow.**

T. Point to the part that says **ow** in this word **COW**.
(**C.** points to **ow** in **cow**.)

T. Read this word, **bow-wow**. Tell me what animal makes that sound.

C. **Bow-wow.** That is what the dog says.

T. Read these words.

c. **cow, how, now, sow, vow, mow, row, brow, brown, town, crown, down, frown, prow, prowl, howl, power, shower, flower, tower, clown, drown.**

T. What sound did **ow** have in **low**?

C. The long sound of **o**.

T. When you see **ow** in a word, it may have a sound like **ow** in **cow** or like **ow** in **low**, but if you read the other words you can tell which sound it has. Read this story.

c. **Tom can row the boat across the pond.**

T. How do you know that the **ow** is like **ow** in **low**?

C. Because you row a boat.
