- T. Say the word cow slowly, and give the last sound.
- C. c-ow, ow.
- T. Point to the part that says ow in this word COW.
- (C. points to ow in cow.)
- T. Read this word, bow-wow. Tell me what animal makes that sound.
 - C. Bow-wow. That is what the dog says.
 - T. Read these words.
- c. cow, how, now, sow, vow, mow, row, brow, brown, town, erown, down, frown, prow, prowl, howl, power, shower, flower, tower, clown, drown.
 - T. What sound did ow have in low?
 - C. The long sound of o.
- T. When you see ow in a word, it may have a sound like ow in cow or like ow in low, but if you read the other words you can tell which sound it has. Read this story.
- c. Tom can row the boat across the pond.
 - T. How do you know that the ow is like ow in low?
 - C. Because you row a boat.
