It is admirably adapted as a labor-saver to those farmers feeding green feed to cows, as it can be kept close to the standing feed, and after cutting it can be thrown over the fence. This does away with the use of horses and wagon for this purpose, and is much speedier. The fence can be made any desired height and the sections any desired length up to 18 or 20 feet. It is a beautifier of the farm. It will pay for itself in two seasons. It is easily made and operated. It can be made in the workshop or barn in the winter or during slack times in the summer by any one handy with tools. It solves the problem of snow-drifts by fences, as it can be taken apart and quickly removed and piled up till spring, when it can be quickly reset. Carefully consider these questions:—Of what use is a fence between two crops? How much land have you occupied by stationary cross fences? What are your returns per annum for the same? Is it dirt or dollars? If the land were in crop, what would be your increase? The best is always the cheapest.
