London, Jan. 30.—Plans to promote trade between Canada and Russia have apparently fallen through. On the Russian side, the trade delegation which thad been arranged with Col. Mackie, M. P., on behalf of the late Canadian Government, would-be sent to the Dominion, has been indefinitely postponed, and this will in all probability not be sent. This is probably the result of the granting of a large credit to Russia for seed grain purchases by the United States Government.

The Canadian Trade Department, which had intended to send Commissioner L. D. Wilgress to Russia, has now detailed him for work in connection with the campaign to induce British manufacturers to build branch factories in Canada.
