mer resolution of Jan. 11, relative to the dismissal of the engineers, and in view of the joint agreement entered into between the city council and the water commissioners, and in the event of the city council, retaining the services of Mr. Van Cleave until March 1, that we agree to pay out proportion of the salary up to that date.

"Was this resolution passed unanimously?" asked Ald. Cooper. "It was," answered Mr. O'Brien.

**Mr. Van Cleave Heard.** Mr. Van Cleave was then asked to give his statement. He thanked the committee for the fairness with which the case had been presented at the meeting, particularly by Chairman Pocock. During the hearing, his remarks he did not wish to appear in the position of criticizing his superiors, but he merely wished to relate the facts of the matter from his standpoint.

As he had really never been recognized by the commission he did not feel that he was in a position to point out the treatment he had been subjected to.

The matter of the vacancy here was brought to the attention in July last, and his name was submitted. He was asked to come to the city of London, and he did so, and was given to understand that all the civic engineering departments were over the local situation he determined to apply, and his application, with testimonials, was put in. "We certainly expected you to take over the engineering work," said Mr. Pocock. "But communication referred to the employment of operators."

executive of the city. He thought that his experience with some of the large companies would be of value to the city. ### The Backbone Question.

### Asked to Take Charge.

Later the commissioners stated that he should take charge, both of the general scheme and the details. This was too much to do, it was too much work, and he could not be expected to do it all. 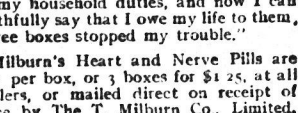
