### WHO CAN WORK FOR YOU BEST?

Records of Mr. White at Ottawa and Mr. Little in London Compared.

The first consideration of every voter in deciding which candidate he will support for the federal parliament should be the question of the national issues involved. In the present election these boil down to a choice between optimism and faith in Canada on one hand and pessimism and doubt on the other.

A second and perhaps equally important consideration, however, is the necessity of securing an active and energetic member to represent the claims and sentiment of the particular constituency.

The people of London for example, owe it to themselves to have an agent at Ottawa who will be active in their behalf and who will be in a position to secure advantages which the city requires.

RECORDS ARE OBTAINED.

To assist in this consideration The Advertiser has secured information regarding the records of both Mr. J. F. White and Mr. E. S. Little. In Mr. White's case the facts were obtained by examining in Ottawa the complete Hansard reports for four years of parliament. In Mr. Little's case the information was found in the minutes and official records at the city hall, reporting his work during his six years as alderman, controller and mayor. In both cases the information is available to anyone by application either in Ottawa or to the city clerk. It is reported fully on page 11 of this edition.

It is not intended as any unkindness to Mr. Frank White to say that he has not been an active representative of London in parliament. It is merely the truth as the facts of his record show. Mr. White himself admits it and has explained that he was unable to accomplish very much because as a member of the opposition party he was "helpless." He has, however, also been absent from parliament to a degree which scarcely seems to do justice to so important a community as London. In the last session, for example, he missed eight out of the fifteen divisions of the house when the business of the country is decided.

MR. LITTLE'S RECORD.

Neither is it intended as flattery or partisanship toward Mr. Little to say that he has done a great many things to help London. It is again merely the truth and the facts prove it. Mr. Little, in two years as alderman, two years as controller and two years as mayor from 1916 to 1921 was constantly active and energetic in the city's behalf. The bare outline of his record from the city hall shows a remarkable constructive ability in pushing forward new ideas and an unwavering determination to secure fair play.

Mr. White explains that he could do nothing because he sat in opposition. If elected now he will again sit in opposition and, accepting his own words, he will again be able to do nothing for London.

MR. LITTLE'S GOOD POSITION.

Mr. Little if elected will be a member of the government and a personal friend of the prime minister. He has been trained in London's needs; he will have the energy and the influence to do things for London.


Both in London's interest and as appreciation for the capable son of an illustrious father the people of London should work for Syd. Little and see to it that he is given a handsome majority on Thursday.

### ROBERT J. FLEMING DIES OF PNEUMONIA

Former Mayor of Toronto Passes Away This Morning After Illness of Few Days.

Toronto, Oct. 26.—Robert J. Fleming, former mayor of Toronto, and many years general manager of the Toronto street railway, died this morning after a brief illness from pneumonia.

News of the death of Mr. Fleming, who had been a leading figure in the business of Toronto for many years, came as a complete surprise to his friends in the city. The street railway executive was 71 years of age, and a week ago last night attended service at Timothy Eaton Memorial church, returning to his farm, at Donlands, about ten miles northeast of Toronto, he complained that he was not feeling well, and it was reported at his office the following day that he was suffering from a chill, but that his condition was not serious. Later in the week it was announced that pleurisy had developed, but it was not thought that his condition was critical.

At the bedside of Mr. Fleming this morning were his sons, Goldie, Murray P. and Russell, and his daughters, Miss Rebecca V., Miss Stella T., Miss Evelyn, Miss Victoria, and Miss Agnes. His son, A. Lloyd Fleming, is in business in England. Another son, Edward Fleming, died in 1901. Mr. Fleming has been twice married. His first wife being Miss Bredin and his second Miss Orford of Toronto. No arrangements for the funeral have yet been made.

OTTAWA FIRE CAUSES DAMAGE OF \$50,000

Stores of Gasoline and Paint Prolong Blaze in Garage.

Ottawa, Oct. 26.—Damage estimated at more than \$50,000 was caused by a fire which broke out in a garage and paintshop owned by Joseph Dufour & Sons, Limited, on Rideau street, early this morning. Two adjoining stores and three frame dwellings were destroyed before firemen were able to control the flames. The gasoline and paint stored in the garage and paintshop added fuel to the flames and exploding barrels greatly endangered the lives of the firemen. No lives were lost, although families in the adjoining dwelling had to make their escape in scant attire. The fire completely wiped out a section of the block, which is in the heart of the lower town district and swept through to the rear of a fire station. The adjoining stores comprised a paper-hanging and paint store, operated by Dufours in conjunction with their other place of business, the Dundas Storage Battery Service, and a soft drink stand. The cause of the fire is unknown.

OCEAN LINERS DELAYED BY ST. LAWRENCE STORMS

Quebec, Oct. 26.—Storms in the Gulf have delayed both inward and outward bound shipping, and the Cunarders Alaunia and Ausonia, together with the White Star liner Regina and the Anchor-Donaldson Saturnia, are considerably delayed in their schedule.

All river traffic in the neighborhood of Quebec is at a standstill and numerous freight steamers are held up at various points along the St. Lawrence shore.

### NEW CITY FACTORY TO START

Canada Buff Manufacturing Company To Give Employment to 17 Hands.

CAPITAL IS \$40,000

Promoters Inspired by Sound State of Industry and Trade Outlook in Canada.

Inspired by the sound state of general industry and the bright prospects for the continued expansion of present progress, a group of London men have launched the Canada Buff Manufacturing Company, capitalized at \$40,000.

A section of the building in Petersburg occupied by the London Metal Products has been secured, and alterations and equipment installations are expected to be completed to allow the firm to begin operations by Nov. 15.

Discussing the firm's plans with The Advertiser, Gordon W. Rickert, president, declared that he had made a careful study of industrial conditions of today and that he had every confidence of the success of the new Forest City enterprise.

Other officers of the company include John Holman, vice-president; W. J. Norfolk, secretary-treasurer, and Harry G. Hunt and John Anderson, directors.

"So healthy is the upward trend in business that we have no qualms about the wisdom of opening a manufacturing plant at the present time," Mr. Rickert asserted. "Those who say that times are not good are dangerous pessimists. On every side are signs of advancement, money circulation has increased, agricultural districts are prosperous, and industries are progressing rapidly."

Having absorbed the Kortum company, the new firm intends to broaden its business to include the handling of all chemicals used in the buffing wheel trade. While buffing wheels will be the basis of the industry, polishes will also be stressed, and this factor is expected to add greatly to the success of buffing wheel manufacturing.

There are three similar industries in Canada, and these are located in Montreal, Toronto and Hamilton," President Rickert pointed out. "On account of this fact, we are confident of a splendid trade in Western Ontario, London, Galt, Preston, Hespeler and other points are good markets for buffing wheels and polishes, and even now we have a strong connection in Toronto. In time we hope to extend our activities to other parts of the Dominion."

When manufacturing is well under way the firm expects to give steady employment to seventeen hands.

MOOR REBELS STILL ACTIVE ALONG ALHUCEMAS COAST

Gibraltar, Oct. 26.—Despatches from Alhucemas Bay show that the Moroccan, hidden in ravines in the neighborhood of the positions occupied by the Spanish along the western Alhucemas coast, are continuing their warfare. They are especially active in the hills of the Boukhouya country, along the coast west of Alhucemas, from which they fire frequently upon the Spanish troops occupying the Blight of Quemado.
