of Town Lots and of Agricultural Land which had been effected during the seven months ending the 30th of April, 1882. The return of the Land Sales for the subsequent period of five months ending the 30th September shows a decreased amount compared with that stated in the last Report, which resulted from the very active and unprecedented deriand prevailing for Land during the greater part of last winter.
