1820. DURING our little expedition to the September. Copper-Mine River, Mr. Wentzel had made great progress in the erection of our winterhouse, having nearly roofed it in. But before proceeding to give an account of a ten months' residence at this place, henceforth designated Fort Enterprise, I may premise, that I shall omit many of the ordinary occurrences of a North American winter, as they have been already detailed in so able and interesting a manner by Ellis*, and confine myself principally to the cir-
