indignation. Since the last election there have been so many changes in this office that no one seems to be personally or officially to blame. The books have been very loosely kept, and under the vague head of "sundries" hundreds of dollars have been disposed of in a way which shows the placifity of disposition of the licentiates of Quebec. The delegations to Quebec to lobby amendments to the Act have been mysteriously expensive. The following is the Treasurer's report as submitted:
