1<sup>ST</sup> YEAR.—Inorganic Chemistry, Anatomy, Practical Anatomy, Biology, Histology, Medical Physics  
(Pass in Inorganic Chemistry, Biology, Histology and Junior Anatomy.)

2<sup>ND</sup> YEAR.—Organic Chemistry, Anatomy, Practical Anatomy, Materia Medica, Physiology, Embryology, Pathological Histology, Practical Chemistry, Dispensary, Practical Materia Medica  
(Pass Primary M. D., C. M. examination.)

3<sup>RD</sup> YEAR.—Surgery, Medicine, Obstetrics, Medical Jurisprudence, Clinical Surgery, Clinical Medicine, Pathology, Bacteriology, Hospital, Practical Obstetrics, Therapeutics.  
(Pass in Medical Jurisprudence, Pathology, Therapeutics.)

4<sup>TH</sup> YEAR.—Surgery, Medicine, Gynaecology and Diseases of Children, Ophthalmology, Clinical Medicine, Clinical Surgery, Practical Obstetrics, Hospital, Vaccination, Applied Anatomy.  
(Pass Final M. D., C. M. Exam.)
