- (c) Item 15: the group of three members of the Commission appointed under article IX of the International Convention on Suppression and Punishment of the Crime of Apartheid to consider reports submitted by States parties in accordance with article VII of that Convention (Commission resolution 1990/12, Economic and Social Council decision 1990/223) is scheduled to meet from 21 to 25 January 1991;
- (d) Item 23: an open-ended working group established to draft a declaration on the right and responsibility of individuals, groups and organs of society to promote and protect universally recognized human rights and fundamental freedoms (Commission resolution 1990/47, Economic and Social Council resolution 1990/40) is scheduled to meet from 16 to 25 January 1991.

In-session working groups

- 4. In connection with item 11, the Commission, by decision 1990/115, and the Economic and Social Council, by decision 1990/249, requested the working group established at the forty-sixth session pursuant to paragraph 3 of General Assembly resolution 44/167 of 15 December 1989 to continue its work as a sessional working group during the forty-seventh session with a view to presenting its recommendations to the Commission.
- 5. In connection with item 20, the Commission, by resolution 1990/45, and the Economic and Social Council, by resolution 1990/39, decided to establish at its forty-seventh session an open-ended working group to continue consideration of the revised draft declaration on the rights of persons belonging to national, ethnic, religious and linguistic minorities.
- 6. Any decisions and resolutions affecting the provisional agenda of the forty-seventh session of the Commission, which may be taken by the General Assembly at its forty-fifth session or by the Economic and Social Council at its organizational session in 1991, will be brought to the attention of the Commission in an addendum to the present document. The annotations to the items listed in the provisional agenda will also be issued in an addendum.
