Although opportunities for spouses to continue in a professional career path are rather limited, experience over the last few years has proven that there are many opportunities for more general types of employment for Embassy spouses. On the whole, with a little perseverance, spouses have been able to locate employment in a fairly wide range of areas.

CIDA has been the most significant employer in terms of numbers of spouses hired. Embassy spouses have been able to find employment either on a short term contract basis or through longer term contracts. Several Embassy spouses currently work as mission coordinators or program assistants to support the CIDA staff working at the Embassy. Opportunities also exist, although more infrequently, for spouses to be hired by CIDA projects. Depending on the requirements of the position, CIDA jobs can be either locally or Canada-hired. Qualifications for CIDA-related positions vary, depending on the requirements of the job. Spouses with particular qualifications who wish to enquire about CIDA work in Indonesia are encouraged to contact the CIDA Indonesia desk in Hull well before departure for the Post.

In the past, some spouses have found employment at the Jakarta International School. For regular teaching positions, the school demands good qualifications.
