The Department of External Affairs in Ottawa and the Ministry of Foreign Affairs of the U.S.S.R. in Moscow made the following joint announcement in the two capitals today:

The Secretary of State for External Affairs, the Honourable Lester B. Pearson, will leave Ottawa on September 30 en route to the U.S.S.R. where he will be the guest of the Government from October 5 to 12, following the invitation which the Foreign Minister of the U.S.S.R., Mr. V. M. Molotov, had extended to him during the United Nations meeting at San Francisco.
