CLARK HOLDS CONSULTATIONS WITH  
NEW BRITISH COUNTERPART IN LONDON

The Secretary of State for External Affairs, the Right Honourable Joe Clark, will meet with Mr. John Major, the recently appointed British Secretary of State for Foreign and Commonwealth Affairs, in London on September 6, 1989.

This will be the first time the Canadian and British Foreign Ministers have held bilateral consultations since Mr. Major's appointment last July.

The meeting forms part of a well-established tradition of annual consultations between the Secretary of State for External Affairs and his U. K. counterpart.

The discussions are expected to cover a wide range of subjects, including Canada-UK relations, Commonwealth matters, East-West relations, developments in the European Community and regional conflict issues.

The Canada-UK consultations will wind up a ten-day visit to Europe by Mr. Clark who also led the Canadian delegation to the Paris Conference on Cambodia and accepted Canada's first invitation to attend, as a guest, the Non-Aligned Movement Summit in Belgrade, Yugoslavia.
