Resolution adopted, 604. Bill No. 444, Mr. Pickersgill, An Act respecting inventions by Public Servants; 1st R., 605. 2nd R., 645. Reported with an amendment, 645. 3rd R., 647. Passed by Senate with amendments to the French version, 703. Senate amendments concurred in, 712. R.A., 736. (2-3 Elizabeth II, Chapter 40.)
