And the House having proceeded to the deferred question on the motion of Mrs. MacInnis, seconded by Mr. Harding,—That Bill C-144, An Act to provide for the management of the water resources of Canada including research and the planning and implementation of programs relating to the conservation, development and utilization of water resources be amended by adding a new subclause 19 (a) (iii) to read as follows:

“(iii) Labelling on containers of cleaning agent and water conditioners, listing percentage contained therein of phosphates or other prescribed nutrients;”
