#### PRAYERS

Pursuant to its Order of Reference of Friday, December 20, 1974, your Committee has considered Bill C-370, An Act to amend the Electoral Boundaries Readjustment Act, and has agreed to report it without amendment.

A copy of the Minutes of Proceedings and Evidence relating to this Bill (Issue No. 5) is tabled.
