

Thorin joins Committee

My dear Minister,

It is a pleasure for me to tell you that at last we have an Institute of Parasitology at Macdonald College, well organized, and in good running order. Already considerable valuable results have been obtained from the investigations which have proceeded all winter.

The Committee consist of Dr. H.M.Tory, President of the National Research Council; Dr. Robert Newton, Director of the Biological Department, National Research Council; Dr. John Todd, who was for many years professor of parasitology at McGill University and who now lives at Ste.
