151. - Marching in Echeion to Reform Line.

On the Left (Centre or Right) Reform Line.—On the word LINE, the leading file marks time; the remainder march to the front and takes up their position in line.

152. Being in Column of Files on the March to Echelon to the Right (or Left).

Echelon-Right (or Left).—On the word RIGHT (or LEFT), the leading file will step short, the remainder will incline to the right (or left) until the left shoulder is in rear of the right shoulder of his file leader, when he will then advance and step short.

153. Being in Echelon to the Right (or Left) to Reform Column of Files.

Reform File.—On the word FILE, the leading file will step short, the remainder will incline to the left (or right) and cover their file leader.

154. Being in Column of Sections to Echelon to the Right (or Left).

Echelon—Right (or Left), Remainder—Right (or Left) Turn. On the word TURN, the leading section will stand fast, remaining sections will turn to the right (or left), and on the command QUICK MARCH sections in rear will move into their places in quick time, their commanders giving the commands halt, left (or right) turn as the left (or right) of the section arrives in line with the right (or left) of previously formed sections.

Quick March.—Or echelon from No. 3 section, sections in front to the right, sections in rear to the left outwards turn, quick march. The sections will turn in the required direction, moving into their places as described above.

Line or column may be re-formed from echelon.
