U. organ. A new department of Sabbath-school work was taken up, Pledge-books being placed in the different Sunday-schools where they before had none. A great many teachers and scholars signed the pledge. In this way children grow up to be strong temperance men and women.

Receipts for the year, \$69.45; expenditure, \$68.14, including \$23 for affiliation fees to the Provincial Union and \$4 to the County. Collected and handed to the District Treasurer for Headquarters, \$675.63.
