

REPORT OF THE DIRECTORS
TO THE
SHAREHOLDERS
OF THE
MONTREAL TELEGRAPH COMPANY,
PRESENTED AT THE

Annual Meeting on Thursday, the 14th January, 1886.

An inspection of portions of the Company's property has been made during the past season by Mr. Cassils, similar to the inspections of 1883 and 1884. His report on their condition is as follows :—

“ In the course of the past year I have carefully gone over many of the lines of the Company finding them in good condition. The Great North Western Company has maintained its usual large staff of linemen, besides employing extra gangs of men in order to effect such additions and alterations as were necessary during the past season. The new lines built are of the most substantial character.

“ The following additions have been made to the lines of the Montreal Telegraph Company :
