Winnipeg, Jan. 21—Hon. Arthur Meighen, in a speech before the Canadian Club here today, outlined the Union government's programme of reconstruction. A large attendance of prominent Winnipeg citizens attended the luncheon and heard the address of the minister of the interior. luncheon and heard the address of the minister of the interior.

"I believed in Union government a year ago—I believe in it today. Granted faithful co-operation within the cabinet and a fair attitude without it means, I think, the best results to Canada. Believing that, my duty is unsparing service as a minister of that government, whole-hearted loyalty to its every member and continued fidelity to its chief, whom I have learned through so many years to honor. That duty I intend to discharge."


