ROBBERIES IN U. S.

Depredations in Last Month Reach Several Hundred Thousand Dollars—Rigid Investigation Being Made.

New York, March 12.—A series of jewellery robberies, totalling several hundred thousand dollars within the last thirty days, has caused New York insurance companies to assign special detective agencies to make rigid investigations.

A \$20,000 loss and a holdup of a jewellery salesman in a taxicab, in which \$15,000 worth of gems were taken, are the latest cases the private agencies are working on.

The details of the \$15,000 taxicab holdup have not yet been given to the public. The private agency for the insurance companies is busy on the case, and when its operatives have assembled to ascertain whether or not the robbery was genuine, the police department will be called in.

The \$20,000 loss involves an automobile also, but the victim instead of being relieved of or lost the package of gems after he had been knocked down by the machine. The victim, Max Rappaport, president of the Standard Diamond Company, 137 Hester street, and he is still unidentified in a hospital. The identity of the victim in the taxicab holdup is being withheld by the Lusi Investigating Co., 16-18 Exchange Place, which is investigating both robberies for insurance companies.

The Lusi operatives frankly stated that gem robberies are being reported to them for investigation at the rate of one or more a day.

"Everyone of them is around \$10,000," said Chief Operative Farley. "We investigate solely for the insurance companies. All genuine. Well, that's what we're trying to find out."

The Lusi agency chief cited two recent cases. Henry C. Hart, a New York diamond broker, was robbed, he reported, of \$100,000 in unset diamonds in an elevator of a business place in the heart of the loop at Chicago, on February 29. His office is at 87 Nassau street, and he reported he had been lured by a false telephone call to the place of robbery.

\$87,000 Theft in N. Y. The theft of \$87,000 in unset diamonds became known February 28 when the details of the robbery of Isaac Levinson, a jewellery dealer, also at 87 Nassau street, were related to a reporter. The robbery occurred February 23, and had been reported to the East Fifty-first street police, who kept it a secret. The theft was done by a clever pickpocket in an East Side subway express.

In the Max Rappaport accident-robbery some of the \$20,000 gems were missing. Some were mounted and some were loose stones. They were in his hip pocket as far as is known when he was struck by an automobile Saturday. His office is at 87 Nassau street at First avenue.

He was unconscious, and was removed to the Harlem Hospital, an institution for negro patients, at Lenox avenue and 136th street. When his wife and daughter called to see him the disappearance of the package of gems became known. He had only \$2.09 in his pockets, his hospital records show, and his watch and chain were not taken.

The Lusi investigating company was notified by the insurance companies, who had been notified by office associates of the still unconscious gem dealer. The agency is trying to locate every person who was near him when the automobile knocked him down and
