Delegates were chosen to represent the International Longshoremen's Association at the New Brunswick Federation of Labor conference to be held in Fredericton beginning tomorrow, at a meeting yesterday afternoon in the association's rooms in Water street. Robert Carlin, the senior vice-president, was in the chair. The delegates elected were J. E. Tighe, John McKinnon, J. Donovan, Robert Carlin, Stephen Stevens and Charles Stevens.

Miss Grace Kuhring, the only daughter of Mrs. and the late Rev. Canon Kuhring, has finished her course at the Royal Victoria Hospital, Montreal, with distinction. She is the winner of the gold medal, the highest prize given in the course for general proficiency. Miss Kuhring led for a percentage of 85. As a A. D. over- seas, Miss Kuhring acquitted herself admirably, winning praise both for her work in hospital and as an ambulance driver.

Capt. H. J. Daubney, who is well known to many of the Maritime Province men who went overseas during the great war, was in the city yesterday. Captain Daubney was with the 5th Canadian Mounted Rifles Battalion in France and commanded "D" company, which at one time was made up almost entirely of Maritime Province men. After being wounded, Captain Daubney was on the instructional staff of the training school for Canadian officers at Bevil.
