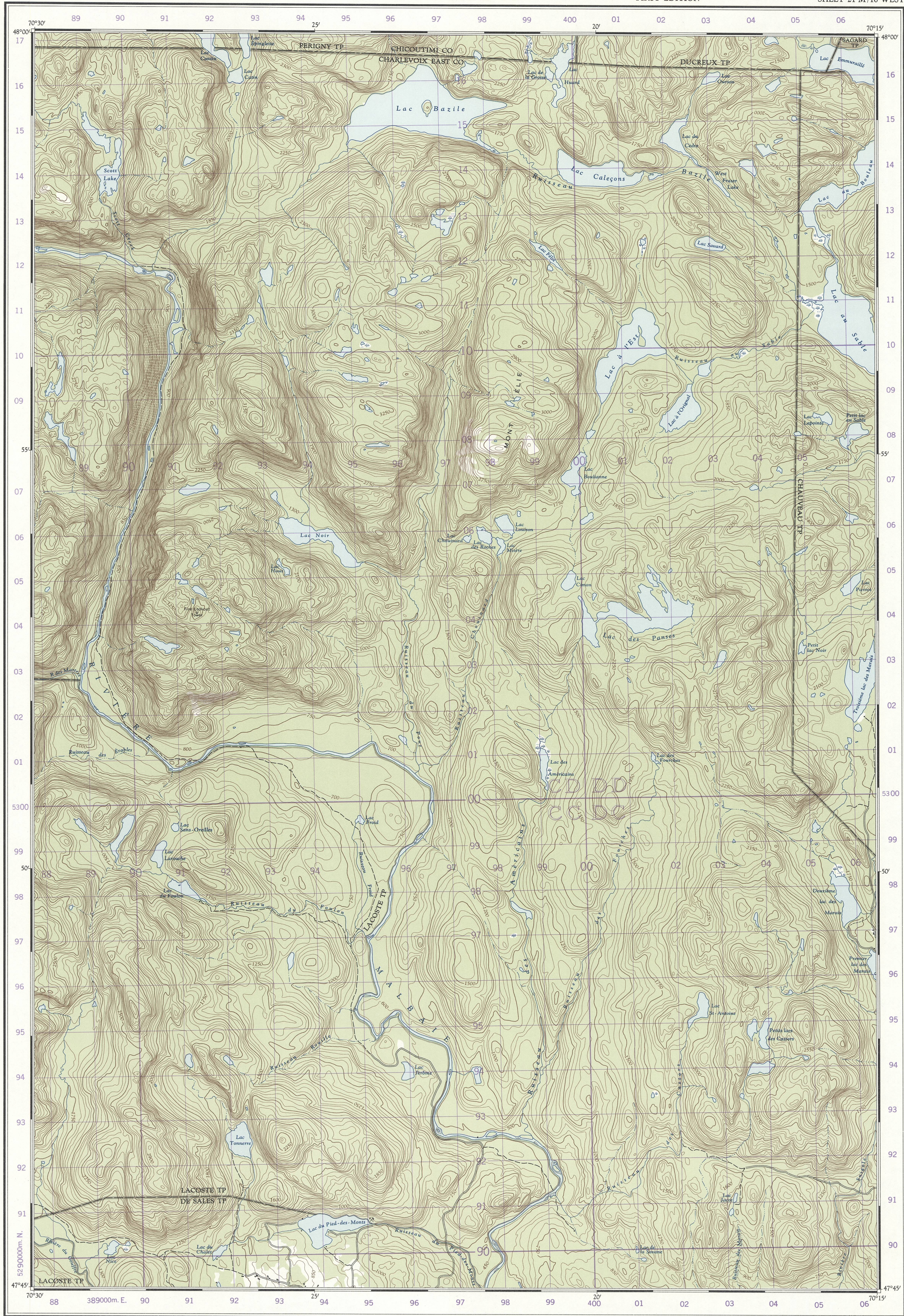
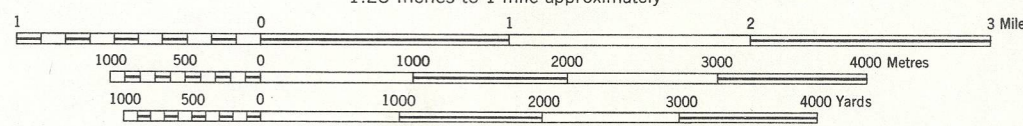

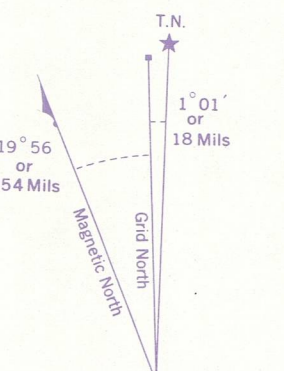

Estimate tenths of a square from

NORTHING: Read number on grid line

Estimate tenths of a square from
this line northward to point.
