Ottawa, Feb. 24.—It has been a day of gloom for the Government. Hopes that the Progressives would be lured into voting against the no-confidence motion of Hon. W. L. MacKenzie King by vague hints of increased western representation through redistribution and by promised tariff reform have been abandoned, for Hon. T. A. Crerar, leader of the Progressives, rose in his seat this afternoon, and after declaring that he had no trust in the redistribution would bring down and that he knew full well that its tariff revision would be guided, as usual, by consideration for the big interests, announced his intention of coming in behind Mr. King and of voting for his no-confidence amendment. The announcement was received with loud cheers from the Opposition benches and in dead silence by the Government forces.


