MILITIA GENERAL ORDER, No. 2.

Whenever any Volunteer Troop or Company of the Active Militia Force of the Province, whether in Class A or Class B, is called upon to act in aid of the Civil Power under the provisions of the 38th and 39th Clauses of the Militia Act, the Captain or other Officer in command of such Troop or Company, shall immediately, after the completion of the duty, make a full Report of the same to the Adjutant General for the information of His Excellency the Governor General and Commander-in-Chief, and at the same time transmit a duplicate of such Report to the Colonel Commanding the Military District in which the Corps is serving.
