

settlement, any separate real or personal property of a married woman, acquired either before or after marriage, and not coming under or being affected by such contract or settlement, shall be subject to the provisions of this Act, in the same manner as if no such contract or settlement had
 5 been made ; and as to such property, and her personal earnings and any acquisitions therefrom, such woman shall be considered as having married without any marriage contract or settlement.

XII. The term "Separate Property" in this Act shall extend, and ^{Interpretation.} apply to all property in any manner acquired by a married woman either
 10 before or after her marriage ; and the term, "Tenant by the curtesy," shall extend and apply to the interest that a husband has in his wife's real estate, during her lifetime.

XIII. This Act shall apply only to Upper Canada.
