Money to be levied by assessment on real property for building a market, &c.

XXII. And be it enacted, That for the purpose of raising funds to provide for the purchase of any real estate for the use of the said Town, for building a market house or other public buildings for procuring 20 Fire Engines, for the securing, raising and paying any moneys that may be borrowed under the authority of this Act, and the interest of such moneys, and for all other purposes deemed expedient and necessary by 25 the said Town Council for the welfare and improvement of the said Town, it shall and may be lawful for the said Town Council to levy an assessment upon all and every person who shall inhabit, hold, use or occupy 30 any house, shop, warehouse, building or piece or parcel of land, being a separate tenement, situate, lying and being within the said Town of Peterboro, according to the value thereof respectively, to be ascertained in manner 35 hereinafter mentioned; and the time for which such yearly rate or assessment for the present year shall be so rated and assessed, shall be held and commenced from the first Monday in January in the year of Our Lord 40 one thousand eight hundred and forty-nine, and shall end on the day next preceding the first Monday in January in each ensuing year, both days included, and the time for which every future yearly rate shall be so 45
