BILL.

An Act to amend chapter 128 of the Consolidated Statutes for Upper Canada, intituled, "An Act respecting the Administration of Justice in the unorganized tracts."

TER MAJESTY, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Assembly of Canada, enacts as follows:

1. The Governor in Council may also appoint a Registrar of Deeds C., cap. 128. in the Judicial District of Nepissing, who shall register all deeds and other conveyances and agreements relating to lands situate in any part of the said Judicial District and laid out and surveyed by the 10 Crown; the said Registrar shall keep his office in a place to be named for that purpose in his commission, or at such other place as may be appointed for that purpose, from time to time, by the Governor in Council, and his duties shall be the same as the duties of other Registrars under the Register Laws of Upper Canada; his fees shall be 15 the same as those appointed by the Consolidated Statutes for Upper Canada, respecting the registration of deeds, wills, judgments, decrees in Chancery, and other instruments, or the Governor in Council may order an annual salary not exceeding eight hundred dollars, to be paid to the said Registrar out of the Consolidated Revenue Fund of this Province, in lion of such fees, which fees shall in such case be paid into such Revenue.
