

Extract from a Despatch addressed
to Lieutenant General Sir Gordon Drummond
H. C. B. by the Right Honorable Earl
Bathest One of His Majesty's Principal
Secretaries of State, dated Downing
Street 10th January 1815.

"If by the due Exchange of the
"Ratifications of the Treaty - Peace shall
"be happily restored, you will not
"fail to make liberal Presents to the
"Indian Nations who have cooperated
"with us. You are to use your
"utmost endeavours to induce them
"to conclude a pacification with the
"United States, on the Conditions
"secured to them by the Treaty."
