Referring to your letter of the 26th ultimo advising me of the road work required on the Pagan Indian Reserve for which an expenditure of \$800.00 has been applied for, I should like to be advised of the exact nature of the work which it is intended to carry out, that is whether it will consist of clearing of brush, levelling, grading, or construction and cleaning of ditches, and whether there would be any carting or spreading of gravel. Please give full details as the department is dubious as to whether road work can be satisfactorily performed at this season of the year.

In case it is the intention to distribute any gravel along the road please state whether same is available on the reserve.
