

Sir,-

Referring to your letter of the 28th ultimo, No. 304-4 A, I beg to state that the authority is granted to purchase a road grader and two slushers for the purpose of making roads and repairing grades on the Kakewistahaw's Reserve. You may also authorize the purchase of about \$100.00 worth of provisions to be used to feed the Indians while they are at work. This expenditure will be charged against the Interest Funds of the Band.
