Sir,-

Referring to your letter of the 1st instant, I inclose herewith surrender documents in duplicate, for submission to the Seton Lake Band and to the Lillicet Band, in connection with the application of the Bridge River Power Company for a right of way 200 feet in width, across the Shalalth Reserve No. 1, and the Seton Lake Reserve No. 5A. You are hereby authorized to submit these surrenders to the members of these bands in the manner prescribed by the Indian Act, and your attention is called particularly to the requirement for furnishing a voters' list showing the number of Indians present at the meeting called for the purpose of considering the surrender, the number voting for the surrender and the number against.
