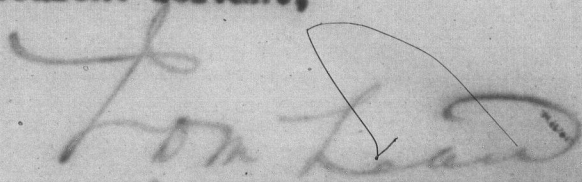
Sir,-
