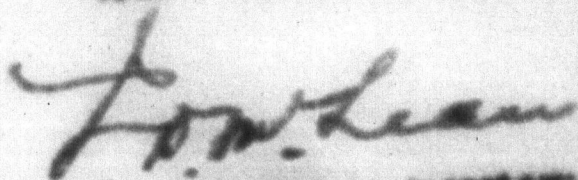

I have to acknowledge the receipt of your letter of the 10th instant stating that the Pas Day school has been closed since Miss Chambers left. as Mr. Ward, who was appointed by the Department, was unable to leave the Mackay school, owing to the shortage of help there, and that Miss Grace Bagshaw has been recommended by the church authorities for the position.

In reply I beg to say that, if Miss Bagshaw will accept this position, you may place her in charge of the school and she will be allowed a salary at the rate of \$400.00 per annum. Kindly advise the Department whether Miss Bagshaw accepts the position or not.
