

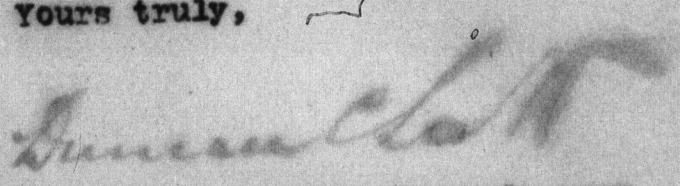

This hospital is doing excellent work, both among the Indians and whites, and I think that it deserves every encouragement. I can see no objection whatever to allowing them to purchase these lands, and I am sure that no better disposition could be made of them.
