Dear Sir  
It was an oversight my  
not answering yours of 3rd immediately  
and then I forgot <sup>about</sup> it. I have no objection  
to your water system being complete across  
the Deadman's Creek Indian Reservation  
as according to the plan shown me it  
will not interfere with the one I  
intend to construct. On the other  
hand a part of my leasehold will  
be served by your system to the mutual  
advantage of both parties. I trust  
the Indian Department will not  
delay your construction on my account.  
It is uncertain when I shall be  
at the Coast. I shall be obliged if  
you will let me know when you  
will be at Ashcroft & perhaps  
I may be able to meet you
