Sir,

I am sending by mail, blank forms
of returns showing the crops sown and
harvested, by individual Indians, also
total of Band.

Please kindly send them in duplicate, to
this Office, on or about the 15th October
next.

I would also request that the head-
ings be not altered, but that the crop
sown be given in acres, and the crop
harvested in bushels. In case the latter
has not been threshed, it should be
given approximately, and in no case
should a return be sent in blank,
unless there is absolutely nothing to show.
