- Q. What happened when you got there?
- A. When I got there the camp was closed and there was just a small skeleton staff. I reported to the skeleton staff and there was a Sergeant in charge of the work party and he didn't know what to do so he advised me to go to No. 2 District Depot in Toronto.
  - Q. Did you get a route letter to go to Toronto?
  - A. No, sir; I hitch-hiked.
  - Q. What date did you report to the depot?
  - A. October 3, the same day.
  - Q. Who did you report to?
  - A. I went into the orderly room in the Horse Palace.
  - Q. That is No. 2 District Depot, Forento?
  - A. That's correct.
  - Q. What did you tell them?
  - A. I didn't tell them I was A.W.L., I asked them under the circumstances if a man were A.W.L. and came back to his camp and it were closed what should he do. I asked what would be done, I didn't say I was the subject of that.
    - Q. Right?
  - A. And he didn't know what to do and he had no advise to give me.
    - Q. What did you do then?
  - A. Sir, I stayed at the Depot and I got a job in Toronto and was working.
  - Q. Did you draw any issue when you were at the Depot?
    - A. I drew a pair of books.
    - Q. What else did you draw?
    - A. That's all.
    - Q. Did you eat at the Sepot?
    - A. Yes, sir.
