Third—Cut around upper end of rectum and draw carefully forward and downward from in front using the knife to cut any connections that might endanger the breaking of intestines while being pulled cut. Open down the centre line, protecting intestines by using blade of knife between fingers of left hand and allow entrails to drop forward. They may now be worked loose with the hands and severed just above the liver and diaphragm.

Fourth—The liver should now be removed, care being taken not to puncture the gall bladder that is attached to same. It should be removed carefully, a little cutting around the neck will enable one to tear it away from the liver intact.
