



General Rules and Regulations

Exhibitors will please read the following Rules carefully, and send in their entries as early as possible, and be sure that all Fees accompany the same

TORONTO, June 4th.

PRIZES

All cash prizes awarded at this Exhibition will be increased by no less than 20 per cent., from the money granted by the Dominion Government.

EQUALIZATION OF FREIGHT

Freight on all exhibits at this Exhibition within 100 miles of Toronto to be paid by exhibitors; the excess of freight over 100 miles to or from Toronto and extending to Montreal on the East and Port Arthur on the West, both inclusive will be paid by the Exhibition Association.

Freight East of Montreal and including the Maritime Provinces, also to Port Arthur, will be paid in full by the Association.

Payments will be made, only on production of the freight bills, from the money made by the Dominion Government for that purpose.

GENERAL

From August 17th to August 28th, the Grounds and Buildings will be open to exhibitors and their assistants only from 7 a.m. to 6 p.m. These are preparation days, and all exhibits required to be on the grounds. All term of the Exhibition must be in place and ready for opening by 6 p.m. on Friday, August 28th.

The Exhibition will be open to the public on Saturday, August 29th, from 9 a.m. till 10 o'clock p.m., and from opening day till Saturday, August 30th, from 9 a.m. till 10 p.m. (except Sunday). The Exhibition will be considered officially closed at 10 p.m. on Saturday, August 30th, after which exhibitors must remove all their exhibits from the grounds and buildings. No removals will be allowed before Monday morning, September 1st, except in the case of Live Stock, which may be removed for the parade of prize winners at 2 p.m. on Saturday, September 1st. Agricultural and Horticultural products, which may be moved at 10 p.m. and 4 p.m. respectively on Saturday, August 30th, and on Friday, September 1st.

The formal opening will take place at 10 o'clock p.m. on Saturday, the 29th of August.

A large number of special features and attractions of the highest order of excellence, in addition to the regular Exhibition, of which full particulars will be subsequently given, will be provided for the enjoyment of visitors.

Intending exhibitors and visitors are particularly requested to read carefully and observe the following rules and regulations governing the Exhibition, which will be in all cases strictly enforced.
