violatil vaso, who reimmediate relief is needed, No's. 1, 2, 3 and 6 may be given together. No. 2 and No. 6 and the composition are given to raise the internal heat and bring on a perspiration; the steam is applied to open the pores and aid on the perspiration. No. 3 is given to remove the canker, and heal the stomach and lowels.

In slight attacks of disease a whole course of medicine will not be necessary; your judgment must be used what medicine to give and how much. In all cases of long standing and severe attacks, a whole course of medicine will be necessary and must be repeated as the case may require.

REJECTED MEDICINE AND PRACTICE.—The use of those herbs and minerals which possess a poisonous nature, such as garden hemlock, (cinta), laurel, swamp dogwood, ivy, arsenic, antimony, calomel, opinm, and the practice of bleeding, blistering, giving many drastric purges, &c., are rejected by Dr. Thomson.
