MONEY ORDERS.

Every money order office in Canada issues money orders on every other money order office in Canada as well as on every money order office in the United Kingdom. Every money order office in the United Kingdom also issues money orders on every money order office in Canada.

MONEY ORDERS IN ONTARIO AND QUEBEC.

All the money order Post Offices in Ontario, Quebec and New Brunswick are authorized to draw money orders on each other for any sum up to \$100, and for as many orders of \$100 each, as the applicant may require, upon the following terms, viz., in Ontario and Quebec,

On Orders up to \$10.....	5 cents.
" over \$10 and up to \$20...	10 "
" over \$20 " \$40...	20 "
" over \$40 " \$60...	30 "
" over \$60 " \$80...	40 "
" over \$80 " \$100...	50 "

MONEY ORDERS ON THE UNITED KINGDOM.

The money order offices throughout the Dominion also draw upon all the money order offices in England, Ireland and Scotland, and the Channel Islands, for any sum up to £10 sterling, and grant as many orders for £10 sterling each as may be needed to make up the amount to be remitted. The terms are as under:

On Orders up to £2	25 cents.
" over £2 and up to £5...	50 "
" over £5 " £7...	75 "
" over £7 " £10...	1.00.
