COMBERMERE. A village on the
Madawaska river in Radcliffe township,
Renfrew County, 60 miles south-west of
Pembroke, the county seat, 54 from Ren-
frew the nearest bank location, 47 south-
west of Cobden, on the C P Ry, and 42 from
Rathbun on the C O Ry, the nearest rail-
way point. Settled in 1864. It contains

Episcopal and Methodist churches, and a
public school, and ships lumber and grain.
Stage to Eganville daily, fare \$2; and May-
nooth weekly, fare \$1. Population, 125.

COMET. A post office in Colchester
township, Essex County, 26 miles south-
east of Sandwich, the county seat, and 10
south-east of Amherstburg, the nearest bank-
ing and shipping point. It has a Methodist
church and public school, and ships pro-
duce. Mail semi-weekly. Daniel Grave-
line, postmaster and general store.

COMMANDA. A country post office
58 miles from Parry Sound, on Commanda
creek (which furnishes power) in Gurd
township, Parry Sound District, 130 miles
north of Barrie and about 30 west of Callen-
dar, on the C P Ry, the nearest railway
point. Nearest bank at Orillia. Settled in
1876. It contains a flour and saw mill,
Presbyterian, Catholic and Method st
churches, and a public school. Stages to
Magnetawan and Nipissing tri-weekly,
fare 5c per mile. Population, 30. Mail
tri-weekly. Thomas Carr, postmaster.
