A Bill to incorporate the Steel, Iron, and Railway Works Company (Limited), was, according to Order, read the third time.

Resolved, That the Bill do pass.

Ordered, That the Clerk do carry the Bill to the Legislative Council, and desire their concurrence.

The House, according to Order, resolved itself into a Committee, to consider a certain proposed Resolution, to exempt from taxation the Canada Vine-Growers' Association.

(IN THE COMMITTEE).

Resolved, That it is expedient that no Duty of Excise Taxes, or other imposts whatever, except Municipal or Local Taxes, shall be exacted or levied upon the business of the Canada Vine-Growers' Association, or upon the manufacture or sale of Wine produced by them, or of any article made by them and used in or about the making of Wine, in the exercise or course of their business, for the period of ten years from the passing of their Act of Incorporation.

Resolution to be reported.

Mr. Speaker resumed the Chair; and the Honorable Mr. Carling reported, That the Committee had come to a Resolution.

Ordered, That the Report be now received.

The Honorable Mr. Carling reported the Resolution accordingly, and the same was read as followeth :-
