WHEAT REVIEW.

There has been practically no change in the price of wheat since our last weekly report. Sales of red have been made as low as 35c when the quality was poor; 37c to 41c was the ordinary price. White wheat usually sold at \$1.01 to \$1.02 in a few cases \$1.03 was paid. The supply of oats has not been so large the last few days, and prices have advanced again; 95c to 96c was the range at close of week. The lowest point touched during the week was 88c for good quality, with some loads of light-weight selling at 85c.

Deliveries of barley continued light. The sample as a general thing is good both in color and weight. Values ranged from 85c to 88c.

Pears steady at 90c to 95c, according to quality. Buckwheat sold at \$1 per 100 lbs. No rye or beans offered.

Butter and eggs are a little unsettled, and have been all week. Closing values in butter were from 12c to 20c per lb., according to make and quality.

Eggs a shade lower. Basket, 16c; single dozen, 15c; store lots, 14c to 15c.

The poultry market was liberally supplied, and on Saturday was overloaded. Chickens sold down to 35c a pair, the range for the week was 40c to 50c.

Turkeys found moderate sale at 10c per lb. Ducks, 50c to 55c per pair.

All kinds of meats were quiet, excepting pork. There was a decline of 15c per 100 lbs. in live hog, and it is likely dressed with follow suit. Closing values, 85c to 87c, according to quality.

Hides, tallow and skins quiet and unchanged. Vegetables were brought forward liberally. Cabbage sold from 20c to 30c per dozen; cauliflower, 25c to 35c; potatoes, 10c to 15c; pumpkins, 10c to 15c; tomatoes, 10c to 15c; other kinds at our quotations.

Hay active and higher, closing at \$20 for best timothy; 30c for poor.
